Manager, Field Services and Seed Certification //

We are currently seeking a manager of our field services and seed certification programs. The successful candidate will provide critical support for the mission of the KCIA in providing integrity-based quality assurance programs to maintain a safe, stable, secure seedstock supply.

The successful candidate will have a general knowledge of production agriculture, an understanding of federal and state standards and seed regulations, or the ability to quickly acquire such knowledge. Experience in the seed industry and at least a general knowledge of seed production and technology is preferred.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities //

- Coordinate all field services and seed certification programs
- Organize and conduct field inspections in support of certification and quality assurance/ identity-preserved programs
- Lead a team of up to 25 part-time inspectors, including recruiting, training, scheduling, and supervising their work
- Conduct on-site inspections of seed conditioning plants
- Participate in education programs for KCIA members
- Develop education and promotional materials
- Represent KCIA on Association and industry committees and at events such as field days

Qualifications //

- Bachelor's degree or higher with experience in agronomy, seed field production or relevant Ag industry
- Experience leading teams, including recruiting, training, scheduling, and supervising employees
- Ability to communicate effectively and interact with colleagues and clients/members in a proactive and professional manner
- High level of integrity and dependability with a strong sense of client/member-focused service
- Experience with basic computer programs (Word, Excel and Adobe) and a willingness to utilize other programs as needed
- The following knowledge/skills are preferred but not a requirement at the time of hire with the expectation to develop the skills through training and education.
 - Knowledge of federal and state standards and seed regulations
 - Knowledge of seed production and agronomic issues
